

LSA GROUP SWIM LESSONS REGISTRATION FORM

Summer swim lessons are intended for those children who would like to learn to swim or improve their basic skills. Lessons are appropriate for your children to prepare them for swim team or to learn how to be more comfortable in the water. Children will be taught by one instructor daily, Monday through Friday, for two weeks. Classes will not exceed 5 students. Classes are ½ hour. You can choose to enroll your child in Session 1 (June 16-27) or Session 2 (July 7-18). Each session is 10 days.

Swim Lessons are \$35.00 per child per session.

In order to ensure the safest and most effective swim lessons, please choose a class for your child based on his/her swimming abilities. We currently offer two levels of lessons, non swimmer (10:30 AM), and beginning swimmer (11 AM). A beginning swimmer is defined as a child who can:

1. put head under water,
2. blow bubbles under water, and
3. float or glide unassisted.

If your child cannot perform **all three** of the above skills, he/she is classified as a non-swimmer and should attend the 10:30 AM class. A child who can perform all three skills is classified as a beginning swimmer and should attend the 11 AM class. The aquatic instructor may reassign students based on her assessment during the first class. Please note that children should come prepared to their first lesson with swim goggles (no masks) and long hair pulled back in a ponytail or swim cap. Swim shoes are not permitted.
